### Uniform- IMPORTANT

On the back of this newsletter is our school uniform policy which is from the School's Prospectus (July 2016). It clearly states that children ONLY come to school in black shoes and black trousers. Children who come in any other shoes but black will be given plimsolls to wear in school. However, it is your responsibility to ensure your child come to school in the appropriate uniform.

# What uniform should my child wear?

We have high expectations of uniform and dress and would ask that all families support this.

## Our uniform is:

Purple sweatshirt with logo

Black polo shirt (preferably with logo)

Black or grey trousers (not jogging bottoms or tracksuit bottoms) for girls and boys

Grey or black skirt for girls

Black sensible shoes (if trainers are worn, they must be plain black with no bright logos or coloured laces)

## We also have a PE/Games kit that we expect children from Y1 to Y6 to wear:

White PE T shirt with logo

Black sweatshirt with logo

Plain black shorts

Plain black jogging or tracksuit bottoms

Suitable footwear for outdoor games

## All our uniform can be bought at K&A Sales in Bridlington or other local outlets.

Please do not send your children to school with jewellery. If they have pierced ears, a pair of small studs is allowed but must be removed or taped over for PE. We would also ask that temporary tattoos are not worn and hairstyles are not extreme (e.g. patterns shaved in or dyed).

# Smoking on the school site

Please be aware that the whole school site is a designated non-smoking area. If you smoke outside the gates, please show consideration for others coming into school and the neighbours by smoking away from the entrances and not leaving cigarette ends.

This includes e-cigarettes as while these are not a proven health risk, we ask that all adults on the site act as role models and set an example to the children.

# Dogs on the school site

Dogs are not allowed on the school site. Please do not bring your dogs into school when dropping off or collecting your children.

This includes dogs which are being carried by their owners. If you tie your dogs outside the gates please ensure they are not in the way of children and families coming onto or off the site.

# Car Parking

Car parking on Moorfield Road car park is free for our parents for 15 mins. at the beginning and end of the school day. For safety reasons we request that vehicles are not brought onto Blenheim Road and Oxford Street at these times.
